

**REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
VILLAGE OF GOREVILLE
September 3, 2024**

On September 3, 2024, at 6:05 PM, Mayor Pro Tem Johnson called the regular board meeting to order, and the room at large said the Pledge of Allegiance. The village clerk conducted roll call, and the following trustees were present: Trustee Trovillion, Trustee Beckmann, Trustee Billingsley, and Trustee Sullivan. Mayor Vaughn and Trustee Benard were absent.

Others present at the meeting were Kyle Schubert, Ryne McNally, and Elle Basler.

Trustee Beckmann motioned to approve the minutes of the August 12, 2024, regular meeting and executive session, the treasurer report for August 2024, and the paid bills for **August 2024**

Trustee Trovillion seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion carried.

The Board reviewed monthly reports submitted by the fire and police departments as well as the water, sewer, and street departments. All the reports are attached and filed with these minutes.

The grapple requested by Matt Russell at the July meeting was tabled as Mr. Russell was absent.

Trustee Trovillion made a motion to approve the replat for Robin Holloway. Trustee Sullivan seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion carried.

The opportunity to manage the Village Park concession stand will be posted on Facebook along with the requirements. Sealed applications will be accepted at the Village office.

Officer Schubert updated the Board on the American Legal Publishing codification proposition. Trustee Beckmann motioned to accept the contract and begin the process. Trustee Sullivan seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion carried. The Village clerk will sign and send the contract. The unsigned contract is attached and filed with these minutes.

There were two Village resident requests for "dead end" or "no outlet" road signage - one at the 300th block of Michael Lane and one on Tepee Ridge. After Board discussion, no signs will be added.

Trustee Johnson shared the Village of Goreville Paths & Lighting Survey Results. There was a total of 248 respondents, and 70% of respondents voted in favor of the project. A resolution will need to be passed and will require a special meeting, which will be scheduled as soon as possible.


At 6:58 PM Trustee Beckmann motioned to enter the executive session. Trustee Sullivan seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion carried.

At 7:25 PM Trustee Trovillion motioned to exit the executive session. Trustee Sullivan seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion carried.


